The change is from qualitative to data based quantitative indicator, evaluation peer judgment with increased objectivity and transparency, in terms of simplification of the process, drastic reduction in number of questions, size of the report, visit days, and so on, in terms of boosting benchmarking as quality improvement tool. He explained who can apply for NAAC and how to apply, eligibility criteria for accredited HEIs applying for reassessment or subsequent cycles, online process, registration process in detail.

There were 54 participants. The participants were from the various states of India like Maharashtra, Goa, Karnataka. We have received 23 research papers related to seminar theme and proceedings of papers published in inauguration ceremony. Participants presented their papers in technical session.
