2. Goal:

The objectives of the Practice:

- To give Swachhata pledge to students and masses to increase the morale and to create awareness in the masses.
  - To make village open defecation free and to involve maximum masses in cleanliness mission.
  - To clean Public and private Campuses and to maintain sustaining cleanliness in the village.
3. The Context: In the month of June 2019 Central government has launched SBSI programme. The NSS volunteer are always engaged to contribute towards plastic waste management in rural areas. The plastic is hampering the environment very speedily. Hence the college decided to participate in this competition. Each intern was active for minimum 59 hrs during 10<sup>th</sup> June to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2019. The 10 volunteers of NSS unit participated in this programme. Adopted village Bramhanagari Phondaghat was selected for the activity. Grampanchayat Phondaghat cooperated by providing garbage collecting vehicle. The local citizen also got inspired and participated in this mission. Various experts from different fields delivered lectures to the volunteers and local people. The volunteers visited the houses to emphasize the importance of cleanliness to the native citizens. Cleanliness Vows and Management Guidance on Cleanliness was given to people. Further the trees were planted after cleaning the areas. Health Leaflets were also distributed to the public with the help of public health center.
  4. The Practice:
    - a) Costing: Free for all students.
    - b) Unique practice: The volunteers got an opportunity to participate in the competition, to fulfil the principle of Cleanliness and social awareness. Very few colleges from the vicinity participated in this mission.
    - c) Constraint / Limitations: this region falls under heavy rainfall, hence monsoon rain created obstacles while implementing this mission. The distance between college and brahm nagari was more. So the volunteers has to walk for long distance.
  5. Evidence of success: Name of the students initiated.

म. गांधी यांच्या १५० व्या जन्मदिनाचे आर्चिष्य साधून स्वच्छ भारताचे स्वप्न साकार करण्यासाठी देशाचे पंतप्रधान मा. नरेंद्र मोदी यांनी दिलेला 'स्वच्छता हीच सेवा' हा मंत्र फोंडाघाट महाविद्यालयाच्या एन.एस.एस. विभागाने अंगिकारला आहे. खरे तर कणकवली तालुका हा कोकण गांधी म्हणून ओळखल्या जाणाऱ्या अप्पासाहेब पटवर्धन यांची कर्मभूमी आहे. या परिसरातीलच फोंडाघाट हे गाव असून येथील विद्यार्थी अप्पासाहेबांच्या स्वच्छताविषयक विचाराने प्रभावित झालेले आहेत. म्हणूनच गतवर्षी सिंधुदुर्ग जिल्हाने स्वच्छ भारत अभियानात अव्वल स्थान मिळवले होते. हे सातत्य टिकविण्यासाठी फोंडाघाट महाविद्यालयातील एन.एस.एस. विभागामार्फत विविध नाविन्यपूर्ण उपक्रमांचे आयोजन करण्यात येते. असाच एक उपक्रम म्हणजे भारत सरकारच्या युवक कल्याण व क्रीडा मंत्रालयाच्या निर्देशानुसार मुंबई विद्यापीठातर्फे राबविण्यात आलेला 'स्वच्छ भारत पंधरवडा २०१९' होय. या कार्यक्रमाचा एक भाग होऊन स्वच्छ भारत घडविण्याच्या दिशेने आमच्या महाविद्यालयातील एनएसएस विभागाने १ ते १५ ऑगस्ट २०१९ या कालावधीत स्वच्छ भारत अभियानाचे आयोजन करून प्रबोधनपर व क्रतीकार्यक्रम राबविले.

स्वच्छतेचा थेट संबंध आरोग्याशी असून समाजात आरोग्यदायी वातावरण निर्माण करण्यासाठी स्वच्छतेच्या सवयी अंगिकारल्या जाणे महत्त्वाचे आहे. नागरिकांमध्ये स्वच्छता व आरोग्याच्या चांगल्या सवयी रुजाव्यात, स्वच्छतेविषयी त्यांची समज वाढावी, यासाठी हे उपक्रम महत्त्वाचे ठरले आहेत. स्वच्छताविषयक शपथ घेणे, स्वच्छतेविषयी मार्गदर्शन, परिसर स्वच्छता, मैदान व बागेची स्वच्छता, वर्गखोल्या, कार्यालय, ग्रंथालय यांची स्वच्छता, व्रक्षारोपण, वैयक्तिक स्वच्छता, शौचालय वापरण्याचा संदेश, मेळावे, पदयात्रा या उपक्रमामुळे स्वच्छतेचा संदेश घरोघरी पोहोचविण्यात महाविद्यालयाला यश मिळाले आहे. स्वयंसेवकांनी केलेल्या या प्रबोधनामुळे स्वच्छताविषयक जाणीवजाग्रती निर्माण होण्यास मदत झाली आहे.





Hon'ble Prime Minister Sh. Narendra Modi urged the people of India to keep their surroundings clean during his first address to the nation on the eve of Independence Day. NSS have been conducting various activities under the cleanliness drive in the past. The following activities are proposed to be organized by all college NSS Units to celebrate the **Swachh Bharat Pakhwada**.

1 <sup>st</sup> August, 2019	All the NSS units will organize one-day seminar on Swachhta, where locally available eminent speakers will be invited to address the NSS Volunteers on the various issues of Swachhta. The event will end with the <b>Swachhta Shapath</b> (Oath) by all the NSS functionaries including NSS Volunteers.
2 <sup>nd</sup> - 5 <sup>th</sup> August, 2019	All NSS Units will devote Four days for cleaning their respective college campus & make the campus plastic free. They will ensure that they clean each & every part of their campus like classrooms, laboratories, libraries, toilets, auditoriums, playgrounds, lawns, roads etc. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All NSS units will work for Promotion of Green Campuses through Tree Plantation and maintenance.</li><li>Activity to be conducted for adequate sanitation in Educational Institution.</li></ul>
6 <sup>th</sup> - 8 <sup>th</sup> August, 2019	The NSS volunteers shall visit the adopted village/slum & take up door to door campaign to make the local masses aware about the importance of cleanliness in their surroundings. During the campaign the discussion will be focused on Open Defecation Free (ODF) village/slum. The villagers will be convinced to construct the toilets in their premises and also to make use of them. NSS units will also be directed to procure informative material like leaflets, handouts from the local agencies working in the similar fields, for further distribution to the people while visiting door to door in the adopted areas.
9 <sup>th</sup> - 10 <sup>th</sup> August, 2019	All the NSS units will devote Two days for intensive cleaning of the adopted villages/slums. Efforts will be made to involve local people so that they understand the dignity of labour and develop a habit of keeping their surroundings clean.
11 <sup>th</sup> -13 <sup>th</sup> August, 2019	All the NSS units will identify locally based 1-2 welfare agencies like hospitals, dispensaries, community centers, old age homes, orphanages, center for disabled, rehabilitation centre, railway station, bus stations/stops etc., and dedicate their services for cleaning the area of agencies and also to take up various welfare activities in the agencies. Special drives may be taken to clean statues & Archaeological sites and tourist Places.
14 <sup>th</sup> August, 2019	All the NSS units will organize rallies in their respective cities/villages by depicting various messages of cleanliness on banners and placards to create awareness in the masses.
15 <sup>th</sup> August, 2019	All the NSS units will hold a meeting of NSS volunteers under the chairmanship of the Head of Institution and will discuss the future plans of sustaining cleanliness in the area. Head of the institution may declare the institution as " <b>Clean Institution</b> "

## **PROFILE OF PHONDAGHAT:**

Phondaghat, as its name suggests, is situated in the hilly and remote area at the bottom of Mountain Ranges of the Sahyadries. It is so famous for honey, that even honey is branded as ‘Phondaghat Honey’. It was a mini marketplace for exchange of domestic commodities for the south Konkan in the past. But there were no facilities of education, health and transportation in the region, because of the geographical restrains. The students had the only option either to go to Mumbai for further education or to stop education after completion of primary education and work in their own small farms.

## **PROFILE OF PHONDAGHAT EDUCATION SOCIETY, PHONDAGHAT:**

We consider it as a privilege to submit the Self Study Proposal of Phondaghat Education Society, Phondaghat, hereafter, PES, which is founded on 28<sup>th</sup> April 1952 with the aim to promote education to the students of rural and hilly region. The PES has contributed its best towards improving the teaching learning process, enhancing student support services and infrastructural development. The vision of PES is to provide the quality education to all, especially to the students from rural, hilly region and socio-economically deprived ones to make them self-confident, employable & self-reliant in the context of glocal competition. It aims at enlightening and empowering the youth, particularly women, to become socially responsible citizen and equip them to compete in a multi- cultural environment.

PES has started New English School (secondary school 1952), Junior College of Arts and Commerce (1975), Junior College of Minimum Competency Vocational Courses (MCVC 1989), Junior College of Science (unaided 2012), Little Flower English Medium School (primary 2016). Further Arts and Commerce College, is established in 1995, which is affiliated to the University of Mumbai and accredited by NAAC with ‘B’ grade in 2016. The update knowledge from primary to higher education is imparted through all these wings to the students arriving from nearly 10 nearby villages.

## **PROFILE OF ARTS AND COMMERCE COLLEGE, PHONDAGHAT:**

Having the motto “Let’s all Enlightened and Meritorious, Nobody be Ignorant and Weak” (*keâª %eeveer iegCeJeble mekeâue, keâesCeer ve jenes De%e otye&ue*), the PES has started Arts and Commerce College in 1995, with the vision of providing quality higher education to the students from diverse backgrounds, irrespective of region, religion, caste, economic strata and academic performance. At present the College offers B.A. and B.Com. under-graduate degree courses of three years duration each. The College sensitizes its students on gender and environmental issues through its curriculum as well as through celebrating national / international days, organizing awareness / sensitizing lectures, street plays, quiz competitions etc.

The developing library of the college has adequate number of text and reference books and offers common internet access for all. The college publishes not only its annual magazine ‘Viveksindhu’ (*efJeJeskeâefmebOet*) with substantial contribution from the students but also the wall papers of the departments of the college. Further, the college library operates ‘Book Bank Scheme for SC/ST students, through the university grants. In addition, Shri Siddhivinayak Ganpati Mandir Trust, Mumbai has also donated Text Books to the library.

Taking into consideration the skills and inclination of the students and the local needs of the time for job opportunities, various certificate courses (career-based add-on courses such as Beauty Parlor, Tailoring, Mehndi Designing, etc.) are run by the college, in collaboration with Janshikshan Sansthan Sindhudurg, which are helpful for the students’ employability in future. The faculty takes several efforts to nurture creative and critical thinking and to develop the scientific temper among the students through Maharashtra

Vivekvahini. Further the college encourages the students to take part in extra-curricular activities by participating in National Service Scheme, Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension, Sports, Cultural Activities, Maharashtra Vivekvahini (*Maharashtra Rationalists*) and Savitribai Phule Women Development Cell etc. to entertain and inculcate social awareness among the students. Majority of the inhabitants are from BPL and EBC families, and are experiencing several social problems like sanitation, poor education and health related issues. The NSS, DLLE, WDC and Vivekvahini units organize annual residential camp, voluntary blood donation camp, health check- up camp, various workshops, discussions, awareness programmes, sensitizing programmes, legal literacy programmes around the year. Many NSS volunteers have actively participated in the state level camps. The students are encouraged to organize cultural programmes celebrating national and international days. The institute provides opportunities to students for participation in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities at university /state/national level such as sports and cultural events. The students actively participate in events as group dance, one act play, singing, poster making, rangoli etc. events every year. In addition, the college library offers Gold Cards facility to meritorious students in curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

The College has a regular Principal, a Librarian and twelve faculty members. Out of these four faculties have passed NET/SET, five have completed their Ph. D. research, five teachers have completed M. Phil degree and two faculties are doing Ph. D. research. The faculty members are continuously engaged in individual research work. Five faculty members have completed minor research projects and three teachers are doing minor research work. Majority of faculty members have published and presented more than 50 research papers in different journals, and books. Four teachers have published their own books; two teachers are editors of academic journals. The College organizes university level seminars/ workshops/ invited guest lectures for imbibing research culture among the staff and the students.

## **THE EXCELLENT ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE COLLEGE:**

The college has won the First Prize in ‘Jagar Janivancha Abhiyan 2013 & 2014’ (Gender Sensitization Mission) at Sindhudurg District and Mumbai University level, awarded by the State Government of Maharashtra, for excellent efforts for empowerment of women. The college has organized two National Seminars, one in Geography on the theme of ‘*Western Ghats and Biodiversity*’ and second one in Marathi on theme of ‘*Paraphrase, Translation and Adaptation*, successfully.

Last year, 35 students of the college have received scholarship from Hindustan Petroleum Company Ltd. (2017-18) and 37 students have received scholarship from Association of Non Govt Colleges (2016-18). A fine number of students from this campus are serving the nation at various places, as well as many students are at abroad.

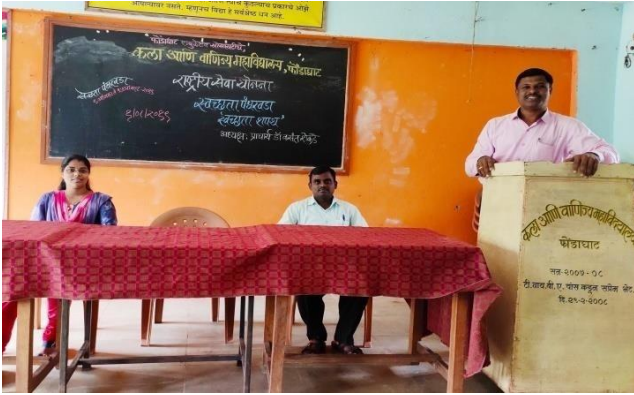
